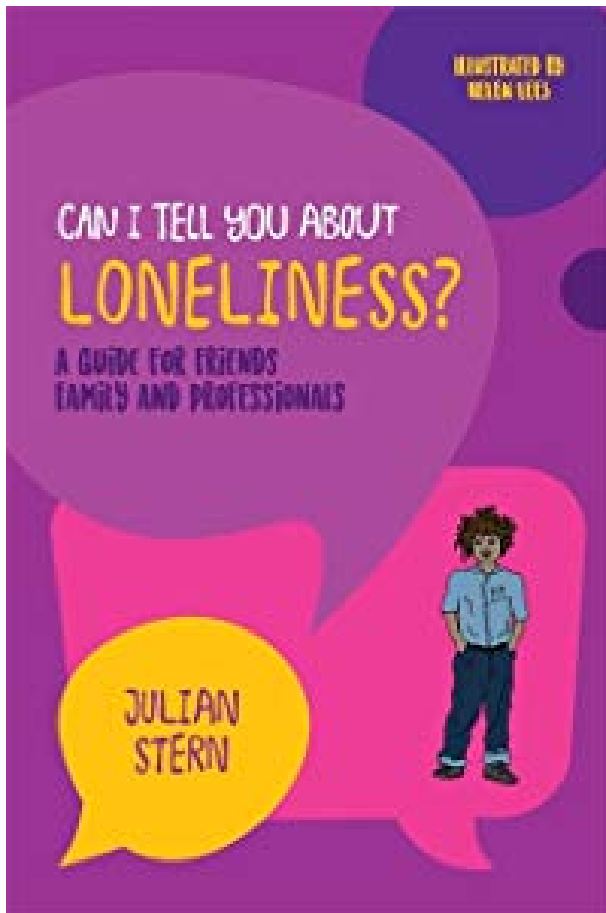


# Can I tell you about Loneliness?: A guide for friends, family and professionals
